Evacuation plan review

- Need an update on evacuation document for name of eScience Institute: name and new director (Andrew Conley (sp?)). eScience vs. Data Science Studio
- Relatively new EH&S Pages give shortened versions of safety procedures generally.
- Questions about evacuation for people with disabilities. Permanent people and longer-term visitors should be asked to document an evacuation plan for themselves. This affects a small but changing number of persons.

- Need updates to people who are First-aid trained and their location. Also eScience

Workplace Security Plan

- Discussion of reporting hierarchy and procedures in cases of workplace harassment. Unit responsibility is to chairs and administrators. Also eScience.
- Discussion of evacuation routes and safe-rooms.
- Need updated list of open but “restricted” areas.
